Howes Primary School, Coventry, UK

Howes Primary School is situated in Coventry in the West Midlands. It was rebuilt in 2006 and it is in a suburban area very close to the city centre. It is a bright and modern school with extensive playing fields and a well equipped playground. There are 240 pupils aged between 3 and 11 years old. We have a unit attached to the school for pupils who have hearing impairments.

We have an exciting and interesting curriculum that has been developed to take account of the children's interests. There are many opportunities to learn outside the classroom and pupils go on field trips to many places. Pupils enjoy making use of a wide range of technology including iPads, mac books, 3-D printers and equipment such as Lego Mindstorms. Pupils can also participate in over 20 clubs which include tennis, dance, German, chess, choir and cooking.

The school is well supported by the Friends of Howes who are a group of parents who organise fundraising activities and social events. Events include a summer fair, discos and bingo nights. Governors also work with the school to ensure that everyone is the best that they can be.
